

Grand Chapter of Royal Arch Masons Of the State of California Scholarship Grant Policy

Qualifications:

- *Must be a member of a Masonic Youth Organization: Job's Daughter, Rainbow Girls, or DeMolay.
- *Must be a U.S. citizen and California resident.
- *Must have a minimum 3.0 Grade Point Average (GPA), unweighted.
- *Must be enrolled, or eligible to enroll, in an accredited College, university or Trade School.
- *Must carry a minimum of 12 semester or 8 quarter units.
- *Must provide a transcript of High School Grades to the Scholarship Committee and transcript of post-secondary grades if a continuing student.

Selection:

Selection will be the responsibility of the Scholarship Committee of the Grand Chapter of Royal Arch Masons of the State of California.

Approval and Award Process:

- *The Scholarship Committee will determine which applicants meet the requirements as set forth by the Grand Chapter of Royal Arch Masons of the State of California.
- *Payment will be made at the beginning of the term, after the recipient has supplied the Scholarship Committee with a copy of the Enrollment Certificate issued by the institution, at the discretion of the Committee.
- *The award will be in the amount of \$500 and may be renewed up to three times upon re-application by the student each year.

Student Responsibilities:

- *Submit the completed application to the Grand Chapter Office.
- *Obtain a sealed transcript from the High School, or post-secondary institution in case of re-application, and include with the application.
- *Obtain two letters of recommendation in sealed envelopes and include with application.
- *New applicants should attach a short essay (approximately 500 words) to the application, describing educational goals, extra-curricular activities, community service, noteworthy accomplishments, special talents and long-range goals.
- *Advise the Grand Chapter Office of any changes in status.
