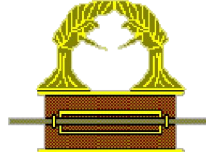

Grand High Priest's Message

Companions All: Happy Chinese New Year (year of the Monkey) on Monday the 8th!



This symbol of Royal Arch Masonry (or something closely akin to it) has been associated with our Fraternity since the inception of the General Grand Chapters in the 1760's (England) and 1790's

(USA). We have been discussing the importance of the symbols contained within this larger context for the past several months and other than to speculate that the color 'red' is a mark of distinction for all Royal Arch Masons as members of a special 'club' within Freemasonry, that of being Past Masters of symbolic lodges (virtual or actual); I will leave this symbology for now and turn to a discussion of the relevance of our Fraternity in modern terms. Masonic Lodges in this country are roughly laid out on the same geometry as Parliament in London (the lower house) with the very important distinction that instead of an altar upon which is a royal symbol of the King (mace) representing the authority under which Parliament can meet and conduct business; we have the Great Lights on our altar as our authority to meet and conduct business! Instead of a Speaker to moderate the discussion and manage the conduct of business, we have a Master (or High Priest) to accomplish the same goal! Both of these institutions were founded on the principle of civility as the guiding moral principle of how best to conduct business and interact with each other as equals of opinion. It is no surprise that this guiding principle has broken down from time to time even in this venue when emotions and stake has overcome logic and reasonable discourse; but despite our human failings, we are honor bound to restore and respect that moral principle as quickly as possible as a condition of calling ourselves Freemasons. Royal Arch Masons have an overarching reason to abide by and promote this principle since we are the designated (by our red coats and obligations) upholders of the moral principles of our order! The analogy of being the High Priest of a Royal Arch Chapter is to lead and instruct the Companions of his Chapter by example on how to instruct and mentor the Freemasons within the Lodges where we all began and set the example of civility, ethical and moral uprightness in our communities in the same manner that the High Priest of Israel instructed the Chief Priests who instructed the Priests (Rabbi's) who dwelt among the people and interpreted the Book of the Law for all to know and hopefully emulate! Semper Fidelis!

This month, as we continue into the new Capitular year, I want to thank all of the Royal Arch Masons who attended gatherings with us in January at the Norris C. Viles, Kern River and Kern Valley Chapter Installations, the San Luis, Corinthian, Ventura and Oxnard Chapter Installations, Orange County and Signet Chapter Installations, Santa Monica Bay and Hanford Chapter Installations, the Western Council AMD Installation and RAM Degree, the Visalia Council Installation and especially the visit of the Most Pre-Eminently Distinguished Governor of the York Rite College of North America to Rosemead! 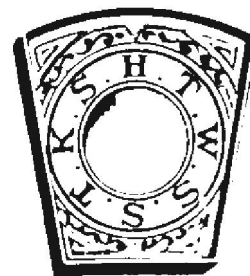

A proposal to amend the Most Excellent Master degree, pages 79-80, and 97

WHEREAS this degree as presently conferred is not consistent with sensible fire code standards;
and

WHEREAS some of the practices for representing the “fire coming down from Heaven” are either ineffective or comedic; and

WHEREAS the circumambulation of this degree uses Psalm 24, when Psalm 122 would be more appropriate because of its references to 1) “the house of the Lord;” 2) the “name of the Lord;” and 3) the term “Companion,”

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that page 79-80 and page 97 of the Ritual Book, 2008 edition, be revised as follows, in order to replace Psalm 24 with Psalm 122, and eliminate the practice of actually using fire in an attempt to represent “fire descending upon the sacrifice.” Non-flammable methods of portrayal may still be optionally employed, consistent with safety and professionalism.

A proposal to amend the Royal Arch degree, pages 117, 118, 150 , 164 and 170-171

WHEREAS the HP has been required to remove his Hat at the Altar prior to prayer in the Opening, creating a certain clumsiness as to where to put it, since it should really not be on the Altar with the Holy Writings, nor should it be on the floor, requiring the HP to bend over when he may have back or knee problems,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that page 117 and 118 of the Ritual Book, 2008 edition, be revised as follows, to allow the HP to leave his Hat in the East before descending to the Altar, as follows:

At page 117

¹¹ **CH** - (*Faces south, turns head east and gives sign.*)
¹² **Excellent High Priest, your order has been duly**
¹³ **executed.** (*HP removes Hat and leaves on chair, and Council*
descends, and with CH fill space in
¹⁴ *circle.*)

At page 118

³² **HP** – (*Recovers Hat from chair and says:*) **Companion**
Captain of the Host, (*faces south,*
³³ *turns head east, gives sign*) **it is my order that a**
¹ **Chapter of Royal Arch Masons be now opened for**
² **the dispatch of business, under the usual Masonic**
³ **restrictions. This you will communicate to the**
⁴ **companions for their government.**

Furthermore, WHEREAS this degree does not explain the first three working tools of a Royal Arch Mason; and

WHEREAS the ritual at other times and in other States has included short text describing these Working Tools;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that pages 150 of the Ritual Book, 2008 edition, be revised as follows, to add text describing the Working Tools, to be delivered by the Captain of the Host after placing tools on candidates, as follows

At page 150

¹ **CH** - (*Returns sword, places crow, pickaxe and spade,*
² *one at a time, on CND's right shoulder commencing on*
³ *his right; naming the tool as it is placed* (**The Crow is used by Operative Masons to raise things of great weight and bulk; the Pick-Ax to loosen the soil, and prepare it for digging; and the Spade to remove rubbish**)

At page 164, the “noble purposes” of the crow, pick-ax and spade are added to the Lecture, after line 23.

¹⁹ **THE WORKING TOOLS OF A ROYAL ARCHMASON**
²⁰ **are the crow, pickaxe and spade, and the square**
²¹ **and compasses, which have been presented to your**
²² **view in every degree of Masonry through which you**
²³ **have passed.**

The Crow is used by Operative Masons to raise things of great weight and bulk; the Pick-Ax to loosen the soil, and prepare it for digging; and the Spade to remove rubbish. But the Royal Arch Mason is emblematically taught to use them for more noble purposes. By them he is reminded that it is his sacred duty lifting from his mind the heavy weight of passions and prejudices, which encumber his progress towards virtue, loosening the hold which long habits of sin and folly have had upon his disposition, and removing the rubbish of vice and ignorance which prevents him from beholding that eternal foundation of truth and wisdom upon which he is to erect the spiritual and moral temple of his second life.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that page 170 and 171 of the Ritual Book, 2008 edition, be revised as follows, to allow the HP to leave his Hat in the East before descending to the Altar, as follows:

At page 170
